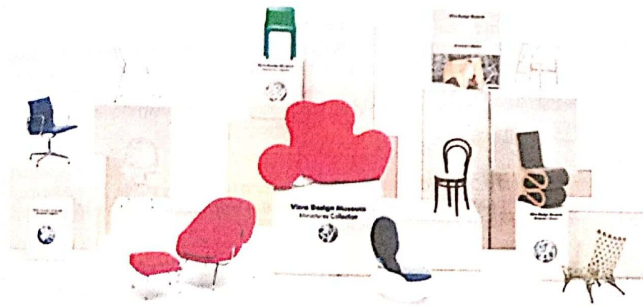

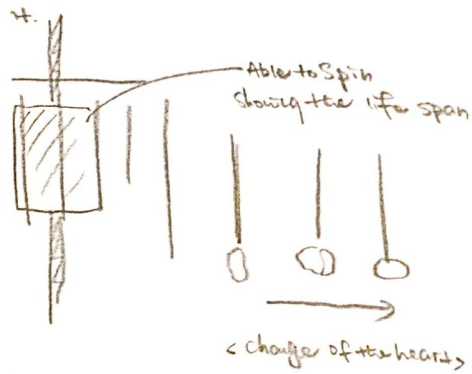


Workshop Description

The visuals are really helpful and more highlight/bold fonts can be used to attract the customers' attentions more.

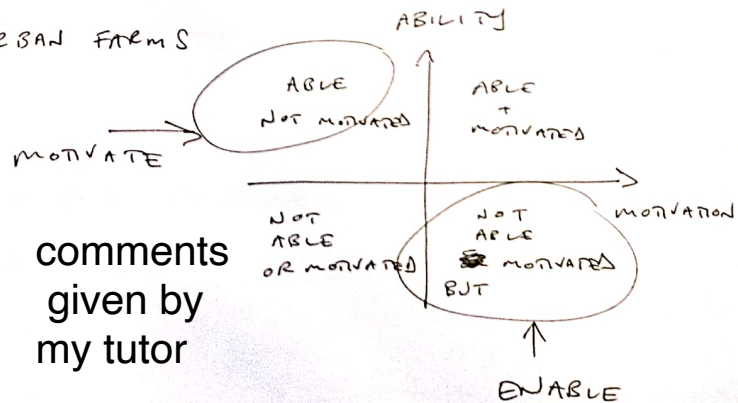
